

### **Using your Autodesk License at home**


If you are considering working from home, or anticipate a situation where you need to work away from the office, your active contract plans entitles you to home use benefits, allowing employees to install and use Autodesk software at home for work related to business, personal education, or training.

Your rights for multiple device usage or “home use rights” are subject to the license type you currently have:

#### **Multi-user/Network:**

Whether maintenance or subscription, in order to access these licenses at home, you will either need to connect to your server through WAN or VPN (set up by IT dept) or You can [borrow a license](#) from your network license server to use on your home computer, or to take home with you on your laptop etc. You can borrow the license from within the software, but you will need to be connected to the server when you do it.

You do not need internet access when using this license, it sits on your machine for the agreed time period.




#### **Single User Access / Standalone:**

Single User access automatically includes home use rights.

The method to set it up is dependent on the contract type:

*Maintenance/Perpetual* – You do not need any home use rights for this, you can install and activate using the serial number and download links from your Autodesk Account. As per the T&Cs for the contract you are only allowed to activate this license on one other machine, i.e. for your home.

*Subscriptions* – You are also entitled to install and activate on up to any 3 devices, you simply just “[Sign In](#)” to activate using your Autodesk account username and password.



To do this you must make sure you have been [assigned a license seat](#) by the Primary or Secondary Admins for your contract.

You will need to have internet access for this to be verified, and activated, and you will need to make sure that your machine can access the internet, as the license will need to be verified with the Autodesk Server in the cloud every 30 days.

Both of these types are subject to the [Autodesk subscription and maintenance plans terms and conditions](#), and only one instance of the software can be active at any given time, i.e either at work or at home.
